

FATHER GERARDO CURTO

SUPERIOR OF THE ITALY PROVINCE



The Superior General, Father Valdir José De Castro, appointed him in the office with a decree of 29 July 2020.

Father Gerardo, 60 years, is from Francavilla Fontana (Brindisi, Italy), where he was born on 26 August 1959. He entered the Congregation in Bari in September 1971. He made his first vows on 7 September 1980, confirming them perpetually six years after. Having obtained his baccalaureate in theology, on 28 March 1989, he was ordained a priest by the laying on of hands of Mons. Armando Franco, Bishop of Oria.

First, he was formator in the community of Vicenza (1988-1993), then, until September 1995, he held the position of Secretary of the Pauline Vocation Ministry in Rome. Later, being transferred to Bari, he remained there until January 2008 as a vocation animator and, for a single mandate (2005-2007), also as Superior of the Community. From January 2008 to June 2014, he was Deputy Director General of the Apostolate of the Italian Province in the community of Milan. After a little more than a year in the community of Vicenza, from 2015 to today he has been involved in the “Santa Maria Regina degli Apostoli” Parish in Rome, entrusted by the Diocese of Rome to the Society of Saint Paul, first as Vice-Parish Priest and then, since 2016, as Parish Priest.
